



Volleyball New Zealand Senior Men's Programme 2011-14

The Senior Men's programme is led by Jeff Jiang (Head Coach), Alani Samia (Assistant Coach) and Bob Shaw (Manager). Warren Smith, as VNZ's new Game Development Manager, will provide support for the programme.

The focus of this programme is qualification for World Championships in 2014. To that end, a four year programme commencing this year and leading to the Oceania Championships in 2012 and World Qualifying events in 2013 will begin for North Island Players with Open Senior Men's North Island trial on Saturday 5th March at One Tree Hill College Gymnasium, Great South Road, Auckland.

Session times are as follows:

9.00 – 9.30	Introduction & Administration
9.30 - 12.00	Trial
12.00 - 1.00	Lunch Break
1.00 - 4.30	Trial
4.30 – 5.00	Pack up and debrief

Athletes will be responsible for their own travel to the trials and for providing their own lunch.

Following the trials, a Senior Men's and NZ Development Team will be named. It is proposed that both teams will participate in the South Pacific Challenge Tournament in Auckland, the week of 25-30 April.

There will be no overseas international event during 2011, but a programme of training camps/sessions for identified talented athletes will be advised, in preparation for 2012 Oceania Championship selections. Two full Men's Programme weekend training camps are planned for 2011 in Wellington; the first in May and the second in late September. Final details will be confirmed.
